

Because there is only one R1.





Possessing a unique power to inspire you like nothing else on two wheels, this sophisticated machine will never cease to impress. Its razor sharp profile, charismatic dual-headlight cowl and dynamic lines convey a real sense of confidence.

And wherever you look, whatever you touch, quality is self-evident.



The making of a legend

Engine/Fuel injection/EXUP

Equipped with a highly efficient fuel injection system as well as a compact tri-axis transmission and torque-boosting EXUP exhaust powervalve, the 998 cc DOHC 5-valve four cylinder engine kicks out the ultimate high-energy supersport riding experience.

Responding instantly to every rider input, the long GP-style aluminium swingarm and ultra-light Deltabox III aluminium frame deliver precise handling characteristics and offer the most astonishing cornering potential in the class.

Front/Rear suspension

You'll feel as if you're connected directly to the road surface thanks to the R1's high-specification fully-adjustable suspension. Transmitting accurate feedback, the highly rigid 43 mm front forks and a reservoir-equipped rear shock make for outstanding roadholding and traction.

The braking system is widely regarded as being one of the best, and features dual 298 mm floating discs slowed by race-developed one-piece 4-piston calipers at the front, and a lightweight one-piece 2-piston caliper gripping a compact rear disc.









The lightweight next-generation instrumentation includes a high-visibility analogue tachometer, digital LCD speedometer and multi-function LCD display, as well as a race-style gearshift indicator that can be adjusted in 1,000 rpm increments.

Everything about the R1 looks and feels instinctively right, including the beautiful 17 litre fuel tank and racing-style rider's seat whose ergonomic design enables you to mould your body close to the bike for optimal handling and high levels of comfort.

The menacing dual multi-reflector headlights accentuate the bike's edgy image, while the sharply-nosed aerodynamic cowl and lightweight screen give that instantly recognisable R1 look.

Taillight
Mounted flush in the slimline tailpiece, the integrated high-visibility LED taillight complements perfectly this class-leading supersport machine's sophisticated high-tech character.

1. Flip-Up screen
Available in either smoke or blue tints, the optional sport flip-up screen gives your R1 a special look – and being 45 mm higher than the standard screen it offers extra wind protection.

2. Seat cover

When you're riding solo on the street or at a track day the YEC-designed seat cover offers extra support during acceleration and gives your R1 an even sharper profile.

3. Solo seat exhaust bracket

Designed for use with the optional seat cover, the lightweight exhaust bracket allows you to run without pillion footrests when riding solo on the road or track.



4. Roller protectors
Easy to fit and designed to mount straight on to the Deltabox III frame, the YEC-designed roller protectors can help prevent accidental damage to your bike's bodywork and engine cases.

5. Carbon fuel tank protectorPre-cut to the exact shape to ensure a perfect fit, the carbon fuel tank protector is designed to prevent scratches to paintwork and helps keep your bike looking 100%.

6. U-lockFor added security Yamaha offer a U-lock featuring a tamper proof lock and hardened shackle.

AlarmThe optional alarm is designed to plug in to the R1's wiring harness, and helps to protect your machine when it is unattended.
